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Wherever possible, all rescued wildlife is primarily the responsibility of the member who is the first point of contact. The wildlife becomes the responsibility of HHWC once all procedures have been followed.

Procedure

- Placement of animals coming in via the groups' emergency phone will be decided by the guidance of the Wildlife Placement Policy and Procedure.
- Endorsed by one other member of the committee
- Volunteers must relinquish wildlife in their care if the wildlife support, after consultation with a member of the committee, deems they are not being cared for appropriately
- Registration of all wildlife (Responsibility of carer with support of mentor) familiarise yourself with all HH Recording processes.
- Each wildlife coming into HHCW Will have appropriate minimum information recorded with wildlife species, sex, weight, history and release plan together with the volunteers or rehabilitators personal details.(See care phone policy and the appropriate format stored electronically)
